YOUR help is needed please

The promenade shelters in Ramsgate are unique and contribute greatly to the street scene of the promenade when travelling along the sea front. These buildings are in a sorry state following years of minimal or misguided maintenance. The local authority has no funds to restore them and has previously proposed their demolition.

The Ramsgate Society is strongly opposed to any removal of these structures and following lengthy negotiations with Thanet District Council, the Society has obtained permission to lease the shelters, in order that a 90% Lottery THI grant can be obtained for restoration of the historical buildings, which have been a very important part of the Ramsgate street scene for over 100 years.

The Ramsgate Society is required to raise 10% of the funding and with an estimated overall total contract value for all 14 shelters of approximately £350,000, the 10% figure is set at about £35,000, the Society is actively seeking donations, contributions and sponsorship for this part of the cost of renovation works. All organisations, businesses and individuals with an interest in Ramsgate, will be approached to contribute to this exciting scheme, which could be a cornerstone for the regeneration of Ramsgate seafront as a vibrant place for residents and visitors alike.

Please Note: Finalisation of the lease is pending and architects have been instructed to prepare documentation for obtaining prices for the contract works.

All organisations and businesses contributing to this major revitalisation of the Ramsgate promenade will be recognised and promoted in our documentation and media presentations about the scheme. We are confident that there will be considerable interest in the scheme once it is publicised and the Ramsgate Society will be pleased to acknowledge its sponsors. Any major sponsorship in excess of £2500 can opt to designate one particular shelter where a plaque will be incorporated into the renovation commemorating the generous donation.
